The Project team has selected in July Ana Pervan (AN) who accepted the responsibility of collecting literature and documentary review and supporting the survey. Ana Pervan has been chosen as she has done a thesis on Data Curation and she is the winner of the IFLA De Gruyter Award 2015 with a paper on data curation.

The Project team has had a first meeting on Aug. 4th planning the activities and sharing responsibilities. The initial coverage of the survey to EU and USA has been extended to Asia, LA and Africa.

The Project is planned to be completed on March 2016. The dissemination of findings will be done participating to Conferences and planning an Open Session during WLIC 2016.

Methodology and preliminary working schedule

The project aims to clarify the role of Data Curator collecting perceptions and definitions about the role and competencies of the data curator at an international and interdisciplinary level.

The objectives are

- to prepare a taxonomy (a list of terms in hierarchical structure)
- and an ontology, using a formal representation of a set of concepts.
